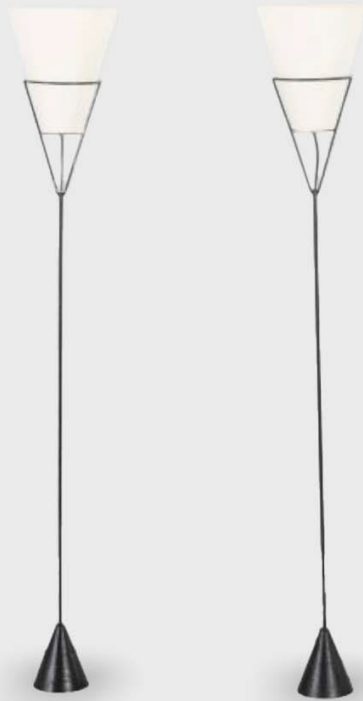

Biography

Founded as a metal workshop for girdling and chasing back in the 19th century, the traditional Carl Auböck workshop is still placed in the 7th district of Vienna in Bernardgasse 23. In the years of foundation the workshop mainly produces the so called 'Wiener Bronzen'. In 1926 the workshop is passed from father to son, who gives it new ideas - the beginning of the typical Auböck design.
