Biography

Luigi Massoni (b.1930, Milan) designer and architect, was in charge of *A&D* in Cernusate (Como). He was a member of the *Milan School of Architecture* and after consolidating his professional career in the 1950s he began to produce important designs for *Alessi*, creating the cocktail shaker (1957, with Carlo Mazzeri) and the Series 5 containers, which are still in production today.

At the end of the fifties, in 1959, he focused on industrial design, becoming a promoter of the foundation of *Mobilia* while, also that year, he joined Boffi as designer and production coordinator, where he developed some of the first modular systems for the home and kitchen.
