Biography

Gunnel Nyman (b.1909, Turku - d.1948) was a Finnish glass and metal artist who participated in the modern movement. Nyman studied furniture design at the *Central School of Industrial Arts* in Helsinki with **Arttu Brummer**, in a functionalist movement. Trained as a furniture designer, Nyman also created metal works for public spaces, notably for the *Swedish Theatre* in Helsinki. During the post-war period, he worked as a glassmaker, for example for *Riihimäki Karhula-littala* and *Nuutajärvi*.
