Celina Zylberberg, along with **Sergio Rodrigues** (b. 1927 Rio de Janeiro, Rio de Janeiro, - d. 2014 Rio de Janeiro, Rio de Janeiro), ignited a modern furniture revolution in 1960s Brazil. A founder of *Boa Vista* tapestry, Celina's legacy spans decades.

Muniz Zylberberg, her son, sensed the modern furniture trend, transforming their textile factory into *Celina Móveis e Decorações*. Combining value and quality, Celina's furniture rivaled famous names like Tenreiro.

With stores in São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro, *Celina Decorações* offered both standard and bespoke pieces. Expanding into office furniture and collaborating with hotels like Othon and Caesar Park, their influence grew.

Under the leadership of designers **Muniz** and **Alexander Zylberberg**, Celina remained a go-to choice for Rio de Janeiro's discerning elite.
