About

Designed and produced exclusively for Side Gallery, this work reflects Mañosa's interest in the tactile and architectural qualities of earthenware, emphasizing the interplay of volume, surface, and subtle tonal variation. The pair's sculptural presence balances functionality and aesthetic intention, demonstrating a dialogue between geometry, repetition, and handcrafted precision.

Biography

Xavier Mañosa (b. 1985) is a contemporary Spanish ceramicist from Barcelona known for his innovative approach to traditional earthenware, often integrating color, modularity, and architectural sensibilities into his work. Based in Barcelona, Mañosa creates sculptural objects that fuse utility with formal experimentation, exploring the dialogue between material, form, and spatial perception. His works are included in private and public collections across Europe and have been exhibited internationally, emphasizing the continued relevance of ceramic traditions within contemporary design.
