About

Centerpiece / Table Jewel, designed by Conie Vallese in Milan in 2026, reflects the designer's exploration of sculptural form within the domestic landscape. Cast in bronze, the piece moves fluidly between function and object, occupying a space where utility becomes secondary to material expression.

Inspired by floral structures and natural rhythms, the work unfolds through organic lines and balanced volumes, emphasizing the dialogue between resilience and delicacy. Its presence on the table transforms a functional object into a focal point, where form, weight, and texture engage in a subtle visual and tactile interplay.

Through this piece, Vallese continues her investigation into the poetic possibilities of materials, creating objects that resonate with both strength and vulnerability while bridging craft traditions and contemporary design.

Biography

Conie Vallese is an Argentinian designer based in Milan, Italy, working across objects, furniture, and sculpture in bronze, glass, ceramics, and textiles. Born and raised in Buenos Aires, her practice is centred on form, material, and process, often inspired by flowers and natural patterns.

Her work moves fluidly between the functional and the sculptural, emphasizing material presence and the interplay between fragility and strength. By exploring the delicate balance between resilience, beauty, and vulnerability, Vallese creates pieces that resonate with both tactile and visual poetry.

Rooted in craft and contemporary design, her objects reflect a dialogue between natural forms and refined industrial techniques, bridging her South American heritage with the creative energy of the Italian design context.
